Each year the Queensland Bridge Association sends a Youth Team to compete against Youth Teams from other states as part of the Australian National Championships.

This year the Australian National Championships are being held in Melbourne from 14 to 18 July.

This is a great opportunity to get to know and play against other young bridge players in a friendly, but competitive, atmosphere. Youth Team members always return from the event with not only improved bridge skills, but tales of the fun they have had.

The Queensland Bridge Association pays for the entry fee, flights, accommodation and a modest daily allowance towards food and incidental costs. The selection process considers not only current playing ability, but also the level of commitment to ongoing bridge development, and how the youth player is expected to improve their bridge in the near and long term future.

To be eligible to play in this year's Youth Team, a player would typically be born on or after 1 January 1994.
