# COVID-SAFE PROCEDURES FOR PLAY

## PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

- **IF UNWELL – Do Not Enter:** *The director has the right to refuse entry.*
- **ENTRY LIMITS:** *Covid constraints specify a maximum of 60 people in the venue plus directors and runner.*
- **Contact Tracing:** *If you are playing, your contact details will be recorded from your entry form and the CompScore record of the play will record your presence. If you enter the venue but are not playing, please record your attendance using the Reefgateway Hotel QR code.*
- **Social Distancing** *is mandatory except when at the card table.*
- **Sanitising:** *Sanitising liquid and cloths will be available at each table. The sanitising liquid must only be applied to the cloths. The cloths can then be used to sanitise a surface.*

DO NOT SPRAY THE LIQUID DIRECTLY ON TO ANY SURFACE.

- **Sanitising Arrangements at the Card Table:** *The playing surface of the card table, the BridgeMates and the card holders must be sanitised as indicated. Sanitiser cloths and hand sprays containing a sanitising liquid will be available at each table.*
  - **Primary Responsibility** *for sanitising will reside with players sitting North-South (but they can ask East-West to assist by mutual agreement).*
  - **BridgeMates** *will only be handled by the player sitting South who will enter the score and show the display to the player on their right who must agree that the score is correct before it is confirmed. Before leaving the table, the BridgeMate must be wiped with a dampened sanitising cloth.*
  - **Card holders** *will be primarily handled by the player sitting North who will offer the card holder so that others can remove or return their cards. If a plastic card holder is being used it must be wiped with a dampened sanitising cloth before the card holder leaves the table.*
  - **The Playing Surface** *must be wiped with a dampened sanitising cloth before leaving the table.*
  - **Card Hygiene:** *The Covid virus lives on playing cards for only a few days. The cards will not have been handled for at least 4 Days and will not be used again during the congress.*
  - **Bidding Pens or Pencils:** *Players must use their own pen or pencil.*
- **General Sanitising:**
  - *Please maintain hand cleanliness. Soap and hand towels are available in the toilets.*
  - *Please refrain from touching surfaces around the club house unless absolutely necessary. Otherwise, please sanitise any surface you touch using the sprays and sanitising cloths available at the card table.*
  - *The Hotel and ABBC Members will sanitise surfaces and door handles prior to the congress, during the lunch break and at the conclusion of the congress.*
- **Food and Beverages:** *Please note –*
  - *Please bring your own cup/mug, spoon and water bottle. The director will indicate when coffee, tea, hot water milk and sugar will be served. Please practice social distancing at this time.*
  - *If you bring lunch and snacks, they cannot be stored in the fridge and food must not be shared with other players.*
