## **Bridge with Richard Ward**

This hand was reported three decades ago by the late and great Australian international player Dick Cummings.

At the table West led the jack of hearts to the 4S contract, won in dummy. Then came the spade 2 - J (a good card) - Q - 5 and another spade which allowed East to draw all of dummy's trumps. Declarer lost two spades, one heart and one club. A less obvious line is available if, at trick two, the spade king is led. This will almost certainly be taken by the ace which later allows a second trump to be drawn whilst leaving one in dummy. The king of hearts is cashed followed by the ace-king-queen-jack of diamonds, throwing two hearts from dummy then a heart ruff provides the tenth trick. Magic!
