
## **Bridge with Richard Ward**

The bidding: 2D either a weak 6-card major suit or strong and balanced; 2H pass or correct; 2NT big hand; 3H transfer to spades; 3NT choice of games. South did well with his balanced hand not to return to spades which has little chance, especially with heart leads which is what West chose against 3NT hoping to find partner's suit. South won this and played the king and queen of spades. On the queen, West followed in tempo with an imaginative and cost-free jack! Declarer, seeing an opportunity to lead twice from dummy towards his diamonds, overtook the spade queen with the ace and suddenly realised that he had accepted a losing option, reducing his spade winners from five to three.
