
Bridge with Richard Ward

1 Limit plus diamond raise

Five diamonds by East was the most popular contract although some East-West pairs doubled four spades and conceded minus 790 for their troubles.

South leads the ace of spades and North is sitting there wishing that partner would give him a club ruff. Is there any legal way to get that message across? Yes there is - and Simon de Wijs for the Netherlands found it. He played the queen of spades under the ace! With the jack on view South realised that partner was endeavouring to send some special message – a loud wake-up call – so he switched to the six of clubs at trick two! A pleased North ruffed this, returned a spade to partner's king and obtained another ruff. This was only worth 2 imps but scored a very high satisfaction rating.
