

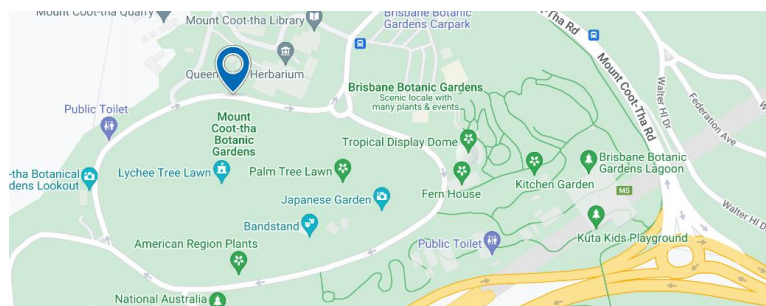


INVITES YOU TO OUR JANUARY CONGRESS 2023
