

Bridge with Richard Ward

In a teams match after a simple 2NT-3NT sequence West began with the two of spades. The first declarer could see no better option than to play for a 3-3 break in diamonds. Given the lead it was unlikely that the spade suit would oblige and there were insufficient entries to dummy to lead low to the heart K-Q twice. So the ace of spades was followed by the ace, king and a third diamond. West cashed a diamond and continued with spades. Later, although a heart to the king won, now there was no way to forge a ninth trick. Declarer had overlooked one additional chance involving dummy's ten of hearts. If the jack of hearts was with West, then a low heart towards dummy at trick two would establish a second heart trick. The moral of the story is to be aware of the power of non-honour cards.
