To reach the semi-finals of the Grand National Open Teams championship it is necessary to survive all five knockout matches or, failing that, to place first or second in the repechage. Of the fifteen Queensland entrants, only three reached the fourth round where they were all eliminated. The 56-board final was fought between CANBERRA 2 [George Kozakos / Ian Thomson / Marianne Bookallil / Stephen Fischer] and SYDNEY 4 [Nick Jacob / Frazer Rew / Ella Jacob / Lakshmi Sunderasan / Matt Smith / Jamie Thompson] ending in one of the rarest of results – a tie! The 42-table Swiss Pairs consolation event was won by Sydney's Emerald Grand Masters and internationals Pauline Gumby and Warren Lazer with the best placed Queenslanders: Tony Treloar / Peter Evans, Pippa & Andrew Hooper and Jill Magee / Terry Strong.

You, North, hold **S** A **H** KQ104 **D** AQ98 **C** KQ102 as partner opens 1NT showing a balanced strong hand. You will certainly be bidding a small slam with hopes of a grand. You check unsuccessfully for a major suit fit then for aces until the iron-clad 6NT is reached. Now, let's peek into the highly sophisticated bidding world of USA experts Larry Cohen [North] and David Berkowitz [South].
