4D was a 'splinter' bid, promising heart support and a diamond shortage. South checked for key cards and bid the slam to which West led the queen of diamonds. How many times have you been told that, once dummy is on the table, you should take time to consider the optimal options? Several declarers looked no further than the seductive club suit for their tricks, hoping for trumps to break 3-2, and clubs 3-3 or 4-2. On a good day this will be sufficient, but not this time when clubs broke 5-1. A far better and safer line that seems obvious when pointed out by a cranky partner, is to simply ruff two diamonds in dummy with the small trumps.

And, speaking of splinter bids, every partnership needs to be very clear about the meaning of 1S-4H. Does it show spade support with a heart shortage or a solid heart suit? This hand, also from Canberra, saw East-West playing in a 1-0 trump fit after an opponent mis-bid showing diamonds when he meant to show hearts.
