

The East-West system included a 3NT opening to show a solid minor suit with at most a king								
outside. This contract is not great and was made worse when South led the queen of hearts,								
then the jack, then the ten, giving declarer a nasty guess which he got wrong for -100. West								
might have looked for a safer minor suit spot. In other matches there was some very								

ambitious bidding to a reasonable club grand slam and a precarious spade grand slam via:

1: shows spades; 2 intended to show a solid suit but taken as a spade raise; 3: key card Blackwood; 4: two key cards and a void. Clearly East and West were on different wavelengths but all was forgiven when the trumps behaved perfectly.
