West led the jack of hearts to dummy's queen and East's ace. Declarer took the heart return with dummy's king and then played a trump to the ace. Declarer's next move was to cross to dummy's ace of clubs and lead a trump, intending to cover East's card. This thoughtful plan would have made the contract if East held the queen of trumps or if West had it doubleton. In the latter case, declarer could have arranged to ruff a diamond in dummy for his tenth trick. Sadly, East discarded a club on the second round of trumps and the contract could no longer be made. West could always win a diamond trick and draw dummy's last trump with the queen.

Another possible but precarious line would be to try to ruff all three of dummy's clubs which happens to work on the layout shown. But the best route to ten tricks is to duck a diamond early and before touching trumps. Then play off ace and king of spades preserving dummy's third trump which is needed to ruff a diamond loser.
