

## **Bridge with Richard Ward**

The Gold Coast International Congress teams championship started with 336 teams playing across five categories and, in the Open, the final came down to an all-Australian team [DALLEY] vs a predominantly New Zealand team [THOMSON]. After 21 deals THOMSON led 55-13 but then DALLEY outscored their opponents 93-8 to take out the title.

This hand from the final illustrates the need to get into the bidding whenever and as early as possible.



Both Wests opened 1C and, when North passed, Nunn-Dalley bid quietly to two spades making 7 tricks. At the other table, Paul Gosney at North overcalled one heart and Tony Leibowitz drove to the heart game making 11 tricks when trumps broke 2-2 and West ducked the king of clubs. 12 imps to DALLEY. One hand proves nothing of course but, overall, bidders are winners.
