
Bridge with Richard Ward



This hand occurred at the recent Queensland Mixed Teams Championship which was directed by Peter Busch and hosted in fine style by the Noosa Bridge Club. A few brave souls opened three clubs as East despite the poor suit and dangerous vulnerability. So, when North-South reached the obvious but doomed four spades, some West's could not resist bidding five clubs as a phantom sacrifice where they were doubled and lost 12 imps for their trouble. At our table Ken Dawson (West) and Adrienne Kelly (East) were defending against the four spades contract which appears to have four unavoidable losers. They played three rounds of hearts, ruffed in dummy. Declarer then drew trumps whilst eliminating the club suit. When ace and another diamond followed, West was not caught napping, rising with the king and snaffling up his partner's queen – a rare 'crocodile coup'. Had he played his jack, East would have been end-played and the contract would have made. Classy defence!
