The bidding was imaginative, especially North's pass over 3D when most would bid rebid hearts with such a dramatic, distributional hand. South's double looks reasonable but the winning defence would need careful handling with all of those diamonds looming in dummy after the ace of spades won the first trick. Next came a club: 7-2-A-Q! This deterred North from the obvious high heart continuation and, when clubs were continued, South later became endplayed to provide the ninth trick - NS -550. At another table, South became upset when his partner removed six diamonds doubled to six hearts, so he redoubled to indicate his displeasure. When the opening lead was the king of clubs that was NS + 2070
