
Bridge with Richard Ward

This entertaining hand from an international event was reported by distinguished journalist Barry Rigal. He wrote: "Never have the commentators' flabbers been so gasted as by the fact that two of the four matches started with a 2C opening by South".



All four matches reached a minor suit slam after spirited major suit interference from East-West. At table 1, the contract was six clubs, doomed by the 5-0 trump break combined with continued spade leads. Down 4. At table 2, North was playing six diamonds and, when East tried to cash the spade ace instead of starting with a club, declarer had twelve tricks. At tables 3 and 4, South was doubled in six diamonds. Both Wests on lead were desperate to reach partner at trick one to get their club ruff. One tried the successful low heart to partner's king. The other tried the nine of spades. Unlucky! Minus 15 imps.
