Minutes

Financial Statement

The financial statement for 2023 was presented. The Zone recorded an annual profit of \$570.86 bringing the balance in the ultimate account to \$10,529.55. Fixed term account stands at \$8873.42 including interest of \$163.83. It was moved Julie Jeffries, Seconded Elizabeth Handley that the financial report be accepted. (*Carried*)

GNOT REPORT (Club Heats and Zone Final)

Entries: 186 teams participated in club qualifying heats. This resulted in 49 teams qualifying to play in the Zone Final. Two teams withdrew and, with the inclusion of a house team, 48 teams participated in the Zone Final at QCBC on Saturday & Sunday 26 & 27 August. Julie Jeffries directed with Assistant Directors, Jo Neary & David O'Gorman. The top four (4) teams progressed to the National Final to be held at QCBC on the weekend of 1 - 4 December.

QCBC has agreed to host the Final in 2024. The weekend of 24 & 25 August 2024 has been approved by QBA. The current format of 4 sessions x 2 matches x 14 boards and the current entry fee of \$200.00 per team will be retained for 2024. Moved Julie Jeffries, seconded Caroline Nelson that the GNOT report be accepted. (Carried)

Julie Jeffries explained the proposed changes from 2024 to the GNOT National Online Qualifying Finals and the face-to-face National Finals and Provincial Final

Interclub Teams Report

QCBC is the host for the Interclub Teams 2023. There are 10 teams entered to play in each of A Grade (Open) and B Grade (<400mp) and 8 teams in C Grade (< 100mp). All grades include a house team. The approved date for 2024 is Sunday 17 November. It was moved Julie Jeffries, seconded Elizabeth Handley that the Interclub Teams report be accepted. (Carried)

There was some discussion on the format of the Interclub Teams. It was moved Jacqui Dudurovic, seconded Sue Kennard that the entry fee remain at \$100 per team and that the host club continue to provide a light lunch. Cathy Mathieson from Redland will discuss at her club and confirm whether or not Redland will host the Interclub Teams 2024.

Julie Jeffries moved a Vote of Thanks to QCBC for hosting both the GNOT Brisbane Zone Final and the Interclub Teams. (*Carried unanimously*).
