## **Bridge with Richard Ward**

A recommended New Year resolution is to bid as the professionals do, living dangerously early and obstructing their opponents frequently. Last week, expert Andy Hung held, all vulnerable, S KQ8652 H void D J10954 C J8 and bid a courageous three spades over an opening bid of two clubs which promised a big hand. The final contract was six spades doubled making ten tricks for -500 – great value when the score from the other table was 2210 for bidding and making the grand slam (A3-AKQJ8642-820-A opposite void-95-AKQ63-K109754) in an uncontested auction.

Your New Year hand appears to have three unavoidable losers even when seeing all of the cards.

West leads the king of spades won perforce with the ace. Next comes a diamond to dummy's nine and the ten of spades  $-\sin -$  three of hearts (!) - jack of spades. West wins an undeserved trick but now it is a simple matter to ruff out the hearts and enjoy three winners there whilst drawing trumps and discarding three clubs from hand. Declarer loses just one spade and one club.
