
Bridge with Richard Ward

The Australian teams for the World Bridge Games in Argentina in October are now finalised. Congratulations to Queensland representatives: Charlie Lu (Open), Jack Luke Paredi (Youth), Andy Braithwaite (Seniors), Jessica Brake (Women's). Pele Rankin (Women's non-playing captain).

North-South were pleased to reach a grand slam on today's hand but, even with no immediate losers, care must be taken to gather in thirteen winners.



The bidding was: 1C:1S - 4D:4NT - 5C:7S. 4D showed a good hand with spade support and diamond shortage. 4NT asked for key cards and 5C showed 0 or 3. West started with the queen of hearts and declarer could see that, if clubs split 3-2, there would be heaps of tricks. To safeguard against a4-1 club break, he first move was to cash the queen of trumps. The king of clubs was cashed then declarer crossed to dummy with the king of trumps to discard the queen of clubs on the ace of hearts. After a low club was ruffed with the jack of trumps, declarer drew West's last trump and was able to establish the clubs – four spades, two club ruffs, two hearts, one diamond and four clubs = 13.
