Bridge with Richard Ward

Today's hand repeats the age-old lesson to count your winners and losers before playing to the first trick. The correct play here is obvious but counter-intuitive.

The auction was a straightforward 1H:2H:4H. West led the nine of spades, covered by the ten and allowed to win. Now the obvious ten tricks (three spades, six hearts and one club) were no longer available. Declarer should simply play low from dummy and win the ace. Draw trumps with the king and queen then play a spade. The defence will take one spade and two diamonds but the club losers will disappear on the winning spades with the ace of hearts available as an entry to reach them.
