Meanwhile, the 8th World Youth Bridge Championships are under way in Wroclaw, Poland and the Under 26 Australian Women's team [Zara Chowdhury, Anne Davey, Diyah Shah, Lauren Morgan, Kate Macdonald & Jasmine Skeate] have excelled by reaching the semi-finals. An outstanding effort.
