- ♣ Maximum 90 pairs. Should we have to limit the numbers, the last entries will be the first to go.

- ♣ Entries will be pending until full entry fee has been received.

FORMAT:

- ♣ Pairs may request to be seeded into a grade above the lowest grade or into A grade.
- ♣ Red, blue, green and brown sticker conventions and treatments. The lowest grades will be restricted to green and blue systems only.
- ♣ QBA approved Red Masterpoint Congress. QBA regulations apply.

- ♣ Contestants entering this event are deemed to have agreed to abide by the QBA Regulations and any additional Regulations made by the Tournament Organiser.
