When South opens, and West overcalls North, has a choice of either showing a limit plus raise in spades with a 3C cue bid or double to bring the hearts into the picture. On the lead of the club queen South must win with the king. If the club ace takes the first trick to lead spades, the club king will get ruffed away - a nasty fate. The best play in trumps is to cross to the heart king (not the diamond ace) and lead a spade towards dummy. Now West can give partner one club ruff only. Note that If the diamond ace had been played at trick two, East will get TWO ruffs. It would be a pity to have fallen at the final hurdle, wouldn't it?
